The Waukegan Public Library Foundation, established in 1986, is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization which encourages voluntary financial support for the Waukegan Public Library. This support will be used to help meet both the present and future needs of the Waukegan Public Library.

The purpose of the Waukegan Public Library Foundation is to enhance the quality of Library services to the community by; securing resources to support library programs and projects not normally met by public funding; to stimulate and encourage gifts of funds, books, desirable collections, endowments and bequests to the library; and receive, hold, manage, use and dispose of funds and properties of all kinds, whether given absolutely or in trust, for the benefit of Waukegan Public Library.

The purposes of the corporation shall be exclusively charitable and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

The Library faces many challenges to stay relevant in the digital age. Collections continue to grow—not only of books, but of audio/visual materials, periodicals, and computerized reference materials. As patrons rely more heavily on the Internet for information, technology and its hardware and software needs make large demands on the Library's budget.
