Deadline

All entries must be received on or before October 24, 2020. Entries may be emailed or attached to the online form on or before the deadline. Mailed entries must be received by the deadline or sooner. Late entries will not be accepted.

Winners

Winning entry will be announced on October 30, 2020. The announcement will be in the form of a video, during which the winning entry with be read aloud.
