14 years of age and older.

Formats Accepted

Short story/essay. No more than 5 pages single-spaced.

Deadline

All entries must be received on or before January 29, 2021. Entries may be emailed or attached to the online form on or before the deadline. Mailed entries must be received by the deadline or sooner. Late entries will not be accepted.

Winners

Winning entry will be announced on February 5, 2021. The announcement will be in the form of a video, during which the winning entry with be read aloud.
