

Waukegan Public Library Study Room Request Form

Main floor study rooms

- Study rooms can be reserved 1 week in advance free of charge for Waukegan Public Library card holders.
- If food is eaten in the study rooms, the room must be fully cleaned after its use.
- Users must be 14 years old or older.
- Rooms left empty for 30 minutes will be passed on to the next waiting group.
- Rooms may be reserved for a total of 4 times per month.
- Patrons may not use the rooms for any of the following activities:
 - o To promote or advertise, directly or indirectly, a commercial product or service;
 - To hold activities or disseminate materials urging support of or opposition to candidates for office in a particular election, or issues on the ballot;
 - o To hold activities or disseminate materials that a reasonable person would deem to be an endorsement of religion or religious belief by the Library or that urges support of or opposition to any religion or religious belief; or
 - o To hold activities that would disrupt the normal operations of the library or involve a threat to public safety;
 - o Private social gatherings.
